Call for application for ToT in Business Entrepreneurship

Partnership in Business Entrepreneurship and Leadership Transformation (PiBELT) is one of the capacity building projects in Bahir Dar University. It has been executed in partnership with Indiana University, Ivy Tech Community College and Debre Markos University since September 2020. - Proven experiences in training manual preparation in the fields of customer development & business model, service design, Go to market strategy, project management, legal aspects of business, financial management, staff recruitment, market analysis, branding, sales and marketing, investor negotiation, pitch competition and other related areas
- Proven volunteer service/community service provision to jobless youth in Business plan preparation, job creation, innovation, technology development and entrepreneurship development
- Commitment to helping young people with conceptualizing, planning and developing innovative and viable business plans to succeed, develop livelihood skills, and to make a difference in their community
